

Community Connections Foreclosure Prevention office relocated to downtown Fort Wayne

Community Connections, the Housing Division of Pathfinder Services, Inc., has been conducting Foreclosure Prevention services since 2007 and now has moved their Loss Mitigation Specialist to their Fort Wayne office.

Mike Davis, who has fifteen years' experience in Loss Mitigation/Foreclosure Prevention, has been employed by Community Connections since 2007. He has relocated to the Community Connections office on the third floor of the CANI building located at 227 East Washington Boulevard Suite 306 this week.

Community Connections Director Jan Baumgartner stated, "The move allows Mike to be more centrally located in Fort Wayne, as well as being able to better serve the City of Fort Wayne, Allen County and the twelve additional counties we serve with this program."

Community Connections' Foreclosure Prevention program was created through a partnership with the Indiana Foreclosure Prevention Network and works with home owners who have fallen behind on their mortgage payments, monthly bills, or medical bills, or have been victimized by balloon mortgages.

After an initial phone interview which takes approximately thirty minutes, Davis reviews the home owner's current financial situation and offers one on one counseling, budgeting assistance, assistance in contacting lenders to renegotiate their loans, and possible referral to other agencies that can provide additional assistance.

Community Connections Foreclosure Prevention serves the counties of Adams, Allen, DeKalb, Huntington, Jay, Lagrange, Marshall, Noble, Starke, Steuben, Wabash, Wells, and Whitley along with the City of Fort Wayne.
